We are pleased to announce the general availability of MN.2019.2.0. This major software release includes Command Recording Software's support for up to 500 cameras, the ability to interface with Command Client via the March Networks Keyboard, several enhancements to Command Enterprise's administrative features, and new hot spare models of the 9000 Series IP Recorders.

Command Client User Interface

Use the March Networks Keyboard to interface with Command Client, and display detailed information for snapshots—overlaid onto the image or shown above the image.

Key Features

Control display resources and activate alarms via the March Networks Keyboard V3

The keyboard now integrates with the Command Client User Interface so you can control display resources (cameras, views and maps) on multiple monitors, as well as activate alarms, switches and talk channels. Additionally, you can play back archived video using the convenient jog dial and shuttle ring, and control PTZ cameras via the joystick.

Display additional information for snapshot exports

Snapshots exported from Command Client now display detailed information about the source recorder, image reolution, and the capture date and time. In addition, you can choose whether to display the information overlaid onto the image or above the image.





Command Recording Software

Support for up to 500 channels

A single server running the Command Recording Software can now support up to 500 camera channels (at 2 Mbps) or 400 camera channels (at 2.5 Mbps).

Starting in release 2.9, the Command Recording Software is now a 64-bit architecture with a 500 camera limit instead of a 32-bit architecture with a 128 camera limit.

Please note, you cannot upgrade to release 2.9 if your Command Recording Software is installed on a 32-bit system. Additionally, you cannot downgrade to a previous release once you upgrade to release 2.9.

Command Enterprise Software

This release offers several enhancements to the user rights features of the Command Enterprise Software, as well as an update to the SQL Server.

Key Features

Restrict global actions for non-global users

You can now "disallow" users with limited territory permissions from making global changes to the system. This allows customers to implement user management permissions without inadvertently giving too many rights to the wrong person in the organization.

Split users' audio and video permissions via March Networks 8000, 9000 and RideSafe™ Recorders

Administrators can grant or deny audio and video permissions separately on a user-by-user basis. This helps protect customers' privacy, yet still enables critical personnel to access the audio if necessary.

Address potential security vulnerabilities

SQL Server 2012 SP4 is now the included standard, this allows you to avoid security vulnerabilities in a previous SQL version.


Support for RAID5 with automatic hot spare
